- **What do you think Confirmation and the gifts of the Holy Spirit will do for you?**
- **What are some practical ways you can be a faithful follower of Jesus Christ after you are confirmed and be a witness to him in word and deed, especially among your peers?**
- **As you think about your future, do you ever talk to God about it? Have you considered seriously the possibility of serving God and the Church as a priest or religious sister or brother?**

You may give your letter to your Confirmation teacher to forward it to me.

May this time of preparation for Confirmation be a time filled with grace and one in which your faith and that of your family and sponsor grows. May God who has begun this good work in you bring it to fulfillment!
